This request for expressions of interest follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in *Development Business* on February 17, 2009.

Montenegro has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) for a Land Administration and Management Project (LAMP).

The Ministry of Sustainable Development and Tourism (MSDT) and Real Estate Administration Department (READ) intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan towards payment for consulting services under a contract MNE-LAMP-7647-IC-CS-13-C.2. for Technical Coordinator/PCU Manager for LAMP Project Coordination Unit (PCU).

The Technical Coordinator/Project Manager will support/coordinate the work of the Project Coordination Unit (PCU) established to assist the MSDT in the overall implementation of Component B of the Project. He/she will also be responsible for overall management of the PCU including four specialists — Technical Coordinator/Planning Specialist, IT Specialist, M&E Specialist and Training Assistant.

MSDT and READ, trough Technical Service Unit now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (CV, brochures, description of similar assignments performed, experience in similar conditions, etc.). Individual consultants may be offered through firms or other organizations, but the qualifications of the individual consultant will be the basis of selection.

Criteria for selection of the consultant will be:

• An advance degree in urban and regional planning or in a relevant field;

- At least 5 years demonstrated experience in urban and spatial planning;
- At least 5 years demonstrated experience in managing projects and staff;
- Excellent communication skills;
- Fluent in English, both written and oral;
- Experience with World Bank or other international projects preferred.

Services are required on a full time basis (eight hours per day) for a period until the project closing date (April, 2014).

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the selection of Individual Consultants-IC procedures set out in the World Bank's <u>Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers</u> (May 2004, revised in October 2006).
